

Tin Cows Tasting Notes



Tin Cows Chardonnay 2004

Aromas of fresh lemon zest and stone fruits. The palate has a combination of a light creamy texture with tight acid, and flavours of peaches with a hint of French oak. The wine has a long finish and good persistence. A nicely balanced wine drinking well.

Tin Cows Pinot Noir 2004

The 2004 Tin Cows Pinot Noir has a lovely spicy and berry nose, with hints of cinnamon and blackberries. These characters are typical of the Yarra Valley, while the concentration reflects the low yields. The palate is of ripe blackberry fruit flavours with fine, subtle tannins, making it very drinkable now, and will also reward cellaring for a few years.

Tin Cows Merlot 2003

The wine has lovely soft berry fruit typical of the Yarra Valley, with a concentration that reflects the low yields. The aroma is a combination of berryfruit and herbs, while the palate is of full blackcurrant fruit flavours with fine tannins. This wine will age well for a few years, but is great drinking now.

Tin Cows Shiraz 2003

Blending more structured fruit from Heathcote with the elegant Yarra fruit the wine maintains its spicy fruit characters, yet is bolstered by fine, long tannins that complete the palate. The aroma has lovely pepper, blueberry and black cherry. The palate opens with plump Shiraz fruit, full yet pure.
